## Winter 2022 MDDE690 Learning to learn online: From novice to expert online learning

This independent study course allows you to co-create a course that focuses on the above topic. A particular emphasis will be placed on online student support for at-risk students.

Learning activities will be negotiated and assignments will be arranged collaboratively ahead of time, and could include redacted interview transcripts, essays, or annotated bibliographies. Course learning objectives will be created with the instructor, but may include objectives such as the following:

- Identify in the published literature the institutional supports most critical to online higher education students.
- Document through experiences, interviews, and literature the recognition of virtual students in need of support.
- Create an annotated bibliography of published research and practice literature about online higher education students at risk and possible institutional remedies.
